
# **CALL FOR PAPERS**

The main aim of the **Journées d'Actualités de Recherche sur l'Ardenne-Eifel** (JARAAE) is to transform the Ardenne-Eifel massif into **a genuine bridge between the four countries** it crosses, facilitating exchanges and collaboration between researchers. Despite the artificial borders that can hamper the implementation of cross-border programs, this coherent geographical area offers significant potential for the development of joint research. The **JARAAE** is a biannual gathering of researchers, with the intervening year dedicated to the publication of the proceedings.

Co-organized by the Centre ardennais de recherche archéologique (CARA), the Station scientifique des Hautes Fagnes (ULiège) and with the support of the Service d'Archéométrie - Archéologie médiévale et post médiévale (ULiège), these international news days focus on a geographical theme: the massif and its margins. The approach is resolutely diachronic (from the Palaeolithic to contemporary times) and open to disciplines related to archaeology (history, toponymy...). In addition to papers and posters, the colloquium will provide ample opportunity for discussion, with a view to encouraging exchanges and the development of cross-border research projects.
